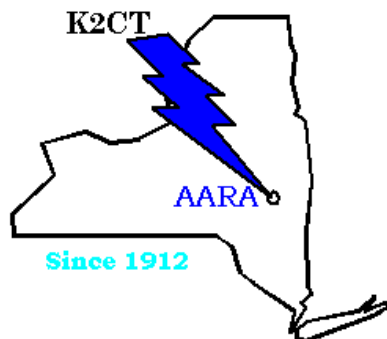

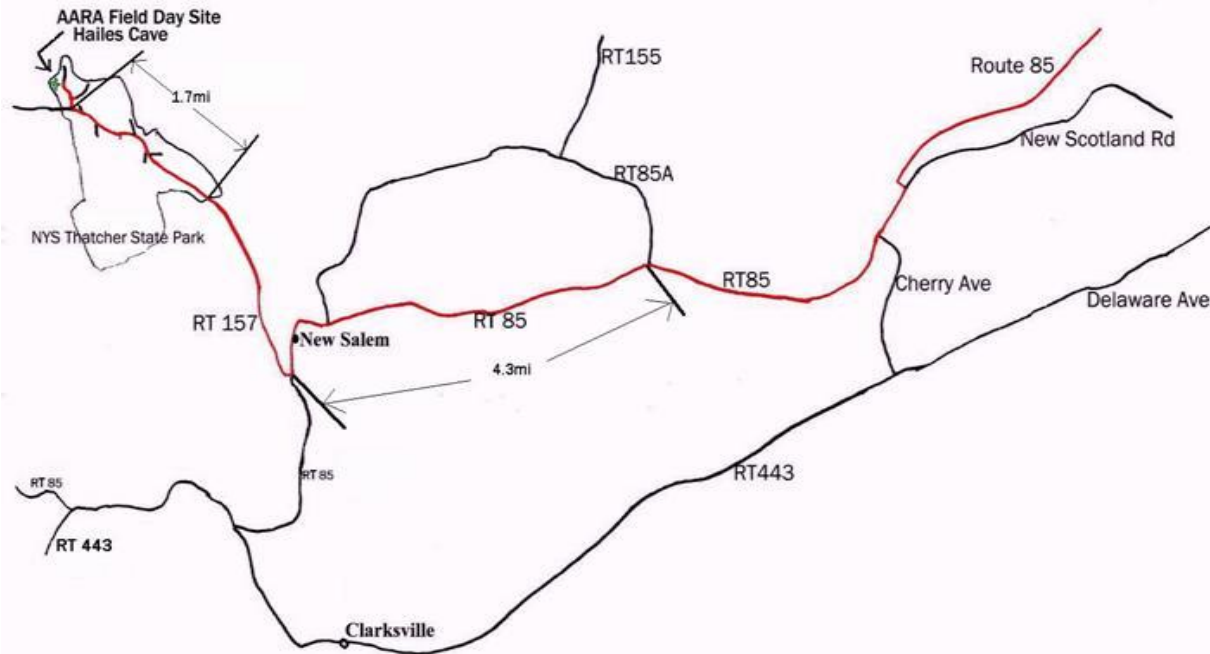
The catering hall is located in the North Shore Tower complex near the golf course. Ticket sales will begin shortly.
